As soon as he hit the beach on the first day of nippers with his son by his side, Ronny started to help and give his time to helping the Age manager and decided he also wants to be part of this amazing movement at South Maroubra.

He joined the club on the 9/9/2007 and achieved his Bronze medallion while still learning from the age manager in his sons group.

All geared up for the following season with his bronze under his belt he quickly became a valued member within the club and became the Under 10 boys Age Manager.

He achieved his IRB crewmans and helped out at all water safety events.

Ronny also joined the IRB team and started to compete.

The 2008/2009 season he was awarded the club Rescue of the Year showing his skills and knowledge within the lifesaving area.

The 2009/10 season Ronny started off achieving his Silver Medallion in Beach Management, Silver medallion IRB Drivers and spinal management setting him up for the year to come.

2010/2011 Ronny was a active patrolling member and now was on the Nipper Committee as Surf Ed.

Ronny's dedication and time to South Maroubra achieved him a major club award of Most Outstanding Senior and IRB person of the year.

He also took up summer surf sport snagging his first State Bronze medal in sprinting along side the South Maroubra Masters Team

To take his competition side to a new level he went to the World Lifesaving Championships and competed as a IRB crewman.

2013/2014 He was elected to be Lifesaving Assistant Director working hard to help run the lifesaving team/members.

He was acknowledged for his hard work with being awarded Patrol Captain of the year and Training Officer of the year.

He also achieved his IRB trainers and helped with the SRC groups going through.

And once again achieving the top 10 patrolling hours within the club.

His love for IRB competition continued and achieved a gold medal at State Championships.

2014/2015 another hard working season for Ronny taking through Bronzies, SRC and IRB groups and helped recruit and retain those members wanting to up skill.

His passion for training was now well established in the club and he is a well regarded dedicated trainer spending hours training our club members.

He maintained his position as Assistant Director of Lifesaving and took on another position on the Constitution Committee.

Ronny was awarded along with his patrol Branch Rescue of the month showing his leadership and hours of patrols learning and sharing with his team achieving a successful rescue.

He was awarded top ten patrolling hours and another year of competing in the IRB arena achieving State Silver Medal.

2015/2016 Ronny was awarded Clubman of the year this season sums up his dedication and love for South Maroubra SLSC.

He continued training many members and kept upskilling his own along the way.

He maintained his positions within the club working hard to make changes and maintain standards within the club.

2016/2017 this season was outstanding for Ronny in the competition area. He trained hard and alongside his Coolangatta Gold team won a Bronze medal and backed it up in the IRB season with another State medal.

He spent many hours at South Maroubra working with all areas of the club from Nippers, Water Safety, Education and lifesaving.

2017/2018 Ronny has maintained to support the club and goes above and beyond his roles within the club.

Huge achievement this season has been to take on support operations and achieving his RWC.

This has broadened his knowledge and understanding outside the flags and now giving more of his time back to not only South Maroubra but to the whole SLS movement.

Ronny this year has patrolled over a 1,000 hours and as of April he is on 1,109 hours over the 10 years of service within the SLS movement.


