- 1979/80 Club receives its first Sponsored IRB from Maroubra Seals Club
- 1980/81 Club attends 3 IRB Carnivals at Soldiers Beach, Elouera and Branch Championships
First full season of patrols with an IRB on the beach.
- 1981/82 Club attends first IRB State Title at Soldiers Beach and makes 2 semi finals.

 - State Results : 3 x semi finals and were one of the only 4 clubs in Metropolitan area to make finals. Mick Sloane, Anthony McKeon, Yvette Noon were our finalists.
- 1983/84 No IRB competition was reported during this season in Annual Report.
- 1984/85 The Clubs gets its second IRB donated by Cut Price Deli – revolutionary boat with a fibreglass hull. The new boat is stronger, faster and easier to maintain.
- Karen Schenk gains IRB Driver award – our first female driver.
 - Bronze Medal NSW IRB Championships at Wamberal B Rescue event – Brett Gibson Karen Schenk and Damien Thomas.
 - Attended Branch Championships with Brett Gibson and Dennis Licari gaining medals
- 1985/86 Club finished 2nd overall behind Bronte in the Branch IRB championships.
- Results: 1st B Mass Rescue, 3rd A Rescue, 2nd B Team, 3rd B Rescue, 3rd A Assembly
 - Two more branch carnival held to select '5' teams to compete in the State IRB Championships which were to be held in August.
- 1986/87 Club competed in 4 IRB carnivals at Wanda, North Cronulla, Avalon and State at North Narrabeen
- Club qualified to compete in all events at State
