PRESIDENT'S REPORT



Colleagues, members, friends, it's with great pleasure I once again present to you an overview of season 2022/23 for South Maroubra Surf Life Saving Club, a memorable season of achievement, service, success, unity and community.

During my journey as President of this club, so much has changed, evolved within our club and organisation with so much more asked of our volunteers during not just on-seasons but off-seasons as well. Surf Life Saving Clubs are now 12 months a year businesses, still run predominately by volunteers on a shoestring budget, gone is the seasonal commitment which many people think or wished still existed.

During this season I officially retired from the NSW Police Force and enjoyed a lovely farewell at our club which I very much appreciated. 36 years of service to the people of New South Wales is a hard thing to walk away from but was made that little bit easier knowing I could give a bit more quality time to our club whilst taking some pressure of my fellow Directors, its fabulous members and our great local community.

To our year in review!

This season South Maroubra satisfactorily completed all of our planned commitments including hosting Carnivals, an Ocean Swim, Fundraising Events, Branch Boatie Presentation, Socials, Sponsorship recognition events. We travelled many miles around New South Wales and even to Perth by road and air whilst also continuing our program of club improvements, progressing future building plans and of course ensuring we looked after our members, supporters, community and sponsors all whilst delivering a successful lifesaving season. We continued to make available our fitness program for our

mature age members named 'Functional Fun Fitness for 40's+' overseen by Jarrod Cullen, completed a 24hr row in aid of Gotcha4life, a mental health fundraiser led by our wonderful Linda, supported by Phil and the many members that participated plus so much more!

Our Social Sundays, which extended into the off-season were a big hit with members and the public alike embracing the 'community club feel' with highlights being plenty of sunshine in our great outdoor space and of course our new BK Bar. We remembered our fallen members; so many great people that are no longer with us but thanks to Linda again, we remember them in a beautiful remembrance ceremony. Our Facebook

site was recognised as the number 1 Surf Club site in Australia with a commanding audience, how good is that!

Michelle Lo our Office Manager did a tremendous job looking after the office admin side of things particularly coordinating the use of our facilities by a wide range of groups including NSW Police Commissioner Karen

Webb and her team, the Eastern Beaches Police Command, numerous schools, indigenous groups from all over New South Wales. We hosted Council run programs, numerous private functions and room hires for things like photo shoots; the money raised through our socials and room hire directed back into improved administrative services. We again hosted the Dolphins Winter Swimmers each Sunday in Winter, Coobra beach swimmers and so many more groups looking for a place to call home.

Our core business here at South Maroubra continues to be **Service, Mateship, Inclusion, Volunteerism**, proven Australian and Surf Lifesaving values that ensure our club is united and strong.

Our Operational Areas 2022/23

Lifesaving – once again led by our Lifesaving Director, and this year's Sydney Branch Volunteer of the Year Nicole Cooney, delivered significant growth within our lifesaving ranks with a good mix of ages throughout most patrols. Fortunately, with Covid just a bad memory this year we experienced surf conditions generally stable with fantastic beach weather resulting in large crowds capably managed by our proactive lifesavers. We took out the Randwick District Patrol Efficiency Award along with Noah Teitler awarded Branch Youth Lifesaver of the Year, a reflection on a very successful season.

It was also so pleasing to see the diverse range of education courses being provided to members from nippers water safety program to seniors resulting in our club completing 1280 awards, quite the effort. The following lifesaving statistics were recorded; **70 Aquatic Rescues, 2520 Preventative Actions, 218 First Aid cases, with 'No Lives Lost'.**

Our Lifesavers were well supported by state-of-the-art equipment courtesy of Club Grant donations specifically, The Juniors Chain of Clubs, Maroubra Seals Club, EBP Club and Matraville RSL. Thanks to our valued sponsors our club was also able to provide not just wonderful equipment but spent over \$10,000 providing a light lunch to patrolling members on each and every patrol plus refreshments after Patrol duties were completed.

Our lifesaving and transport services were greatly supported by Ampol Australia and the Clovelly Community Bank.

We very much value the work our lifesavers of all ages do in supporting our local community and bathing public.

Competition – Led again by Shane White and Maria Garay, this season we again saw our younger 'Open' competitors excel at a range of Pool, Surf, Branch, State and Aussie events throughout the season with our competition future in good hands. Aussie results in Scarborough saw our Masters 'Snagglepuss' boaties take out Gold followed by Gold again for our Masters female relay team. Our Youth excelled picking up Gold in beach sprint male, Gold in male flags, Bronze in female flags, Bronze female beach relay, 5th beach sprint, 7th in belt, finalist in the surf race. Big thanks must go to our volunteer coaches that are the quiet achievers. (A comprehensive list of results is contained within this document).

Our IRB team is heading off to Broulee Surf Club for Round 4 as I write this report and were solid in last year's competition coming 3rd at State Titles with 3 members in the State Team, so great overall effort by South Maroubra Competitors.

Our success this season has been nothing short of outstanding and could not happen without dedicated competitors prepared to train hard plus wonderful 'volunteer' coaches that give up their time to help develop our members plus of course sponsors that provide funding for equipment, shelter for competitors and transport including NSW Ports, Southend Hotel, Sydney City VW, Sublime, Ampol, The Heartfelt Foundation – a Division of the Precision Group (The Marksie Bus), and others. I also

acknowledge Shane White and Maria who have led from the front and been instrumental in the massive resurgence of competition. Remember competition at South Maroubra helps create even better skilled lifesavers so give it a go!

Nippers – Led again by Peter and Mary Kondilios saw yet again a massive turn out of children under the age of 14 with 1150 on the books, in fact the largest Nipper section in AUSTRALIA requiring precise and constant commitment and leadership. Attracting such numbers doesn't happen by chance; South Maroubra is recognised as the place to come to for fun, friendship, skills, and a reliable club to roll out a comprehensive education program in sometimes challenging conditions. If managing those numbers on a Sunday weren't a sufficient challenge, our nipper coaches, parents, and supporters also excelled at carnivals taking out 5th place at State Titles along with staring at the Sydney Branch AOE's taking out the Junior Male Athlete of the Year 9-10's, 11-12's, 13-14's, and Junior Age Manager of the Year.

Once again, a big thank you is extended to our Age Managers, Assistant Age Managers, nipper sponsors including everyone that contributes to our successes both time, materials and financially. We always welcome any extra support as these children are tomorrow's volunteer lifesavers.

With Australia's largest Nipper Club in Australia comes a need to support these future lifesavers and, on that note, I'd like to extend my appreciation to Nixco, Holfords Pool Services, Channel 10, Randwick City Council and Maroubra Seals Club for their support of our Nippers.

To our Supporters & Pollies – An operation the size of South Maroubra SLSC needs many helping hands. I would like to thank each and every one of our helpers, sponsors, supporters, far too many to mention within my report so please take this as a big personal thank you.

that have embraced schooling and education are rewarded with trips to desirable locations. Students and Mentors alike have felt the love and warmth provided by our club and have shared that experience with other chapters of the organisation. Club Constitution & Regulations

Objective 3: of our Strategic Plan Review Club Constitution and Regulations review on a need's basis and a full review for relevancy to occur every 3 years.

Our constitution committee met during the season reviewing the changes made by SLSNSW and ascertaining the timing for any changes/inclusions our Club needed to make to our regulations document.

Clubs are required to have a Child Safe Coordinator with the recommendation that this role be introduced for season 23/24.

The Child Safe Coordinator role is dedicated to improving the safety of children and young people in Surf Life Saving by sharing and actioning child safe information distributed by SLSNSW at a club/branch level. The child safe coordinator does not investigate child-related incidents or complaints.

We are pleased to advise that the recommendation from the Constitution committee was accepted by the Board at our March 2023 meeting and the following inclusion into the South Maroubra SLSC Inc Regulations.

Regulation 4.2.10 Included Child Safe Coordinator: BOM March 2023 Meeting

10) Child Safe Coordinator

- a) The Child Safe Coordinator will be the single point of contact at the club for all child safe information distributed by SLSNSW.*
- b) Review all child safe information distributed by SLSNSW and share with relevant members via the Board.*
- c) Respond to request for feedback made by SLSNSW in relation to child safety on behalf of the Club (e.g., respond to surveys, consult with the Club Board and feedback to SLSNSW)*
- d) Board contact will be the Club Secretary.*

During 2023/24 the constitution committee will undertake a full review for relevancy of both documents. Watch this space!

As a Surf Life Saving Club, we should never forget that keeping the public safe on our beach is and will always be our primary objective. We are lucky to have a talented team of members who dedicated their time and skills to this objective and in such keep our beach safe with expecting nothing in return.

Surf Lifesaving is an institution that offers many avenues and opportunities to people of differing ages, abilities, experiences, and backgrounds. It is quite rare that an organisation provides so many opportunities, especially a volunteer one. 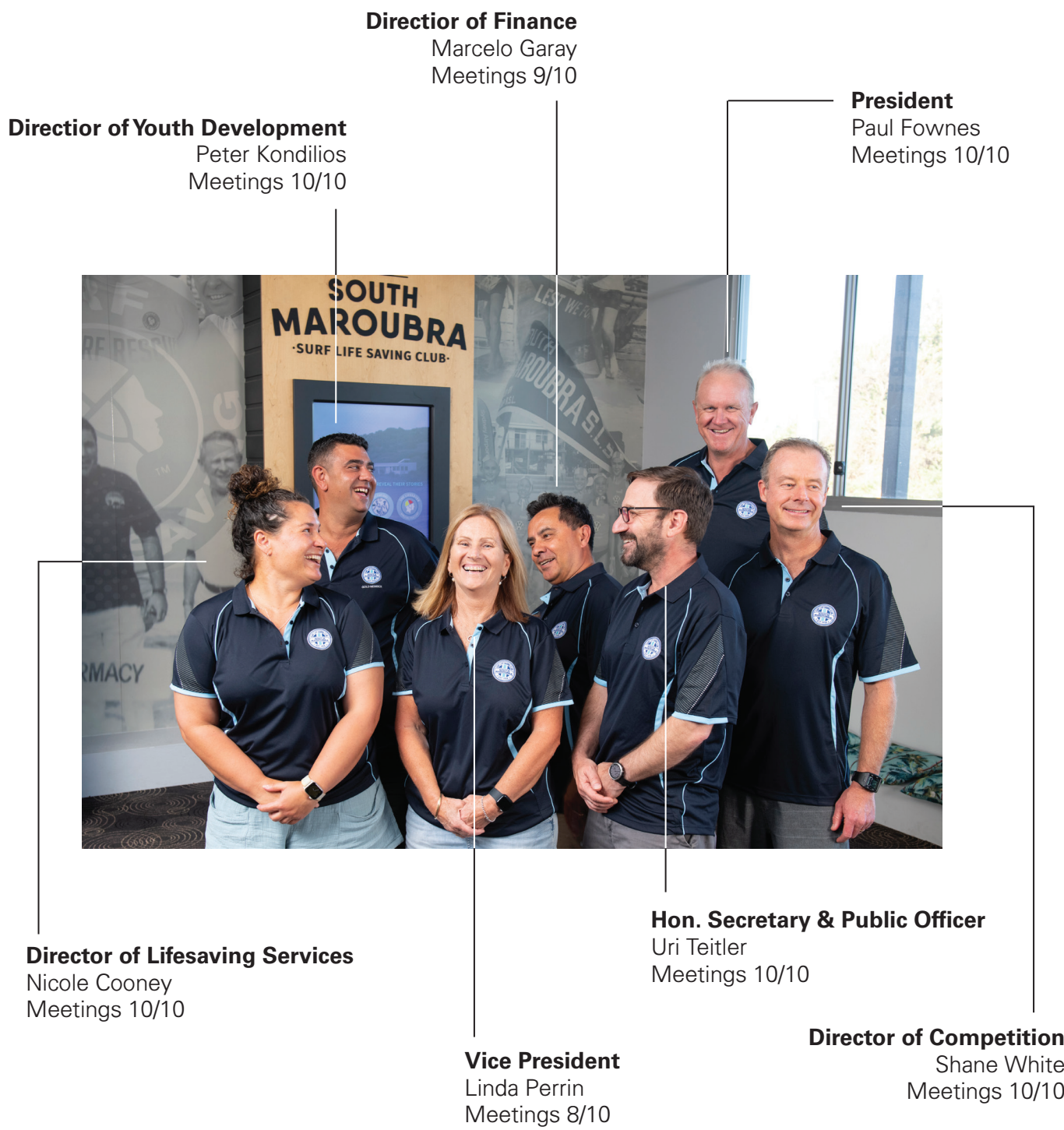
With my second year under the belt, I feel like things are a little more under control but it would not be without the huge support from my fellow members of the Board of Management and of course from Michelle in the office.

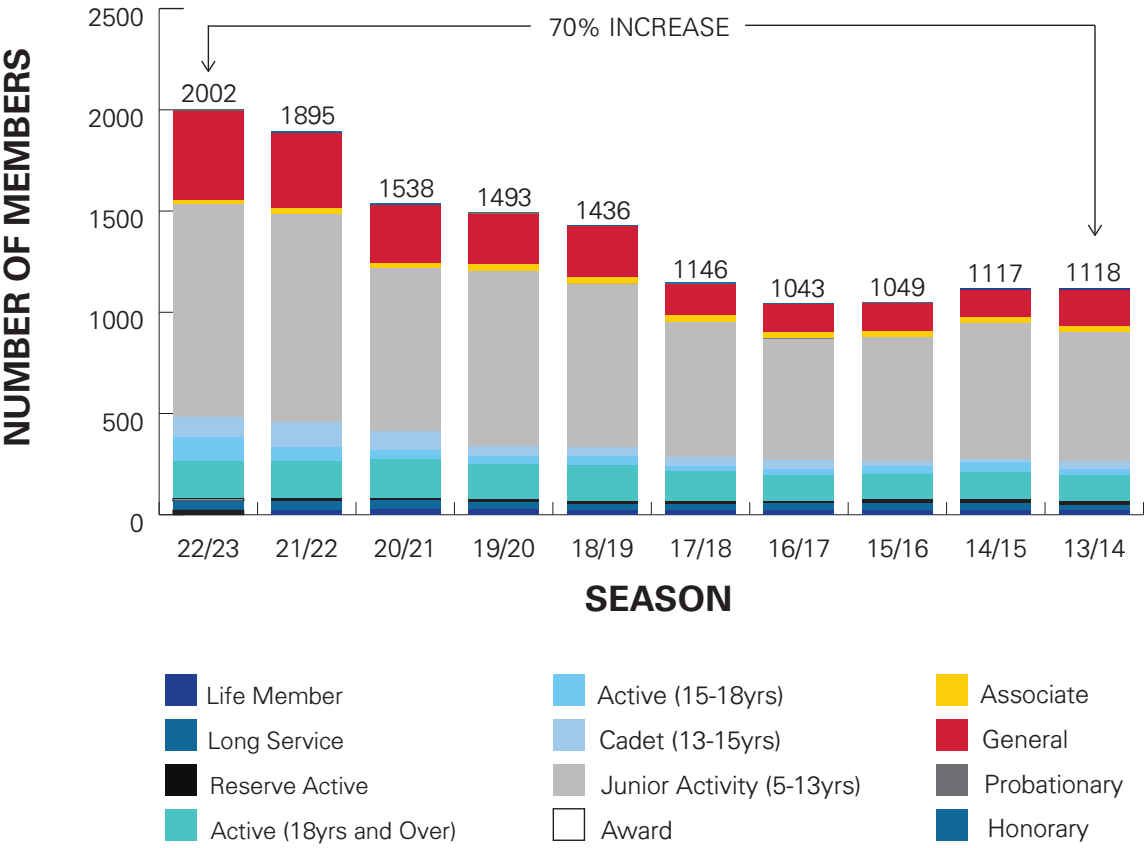

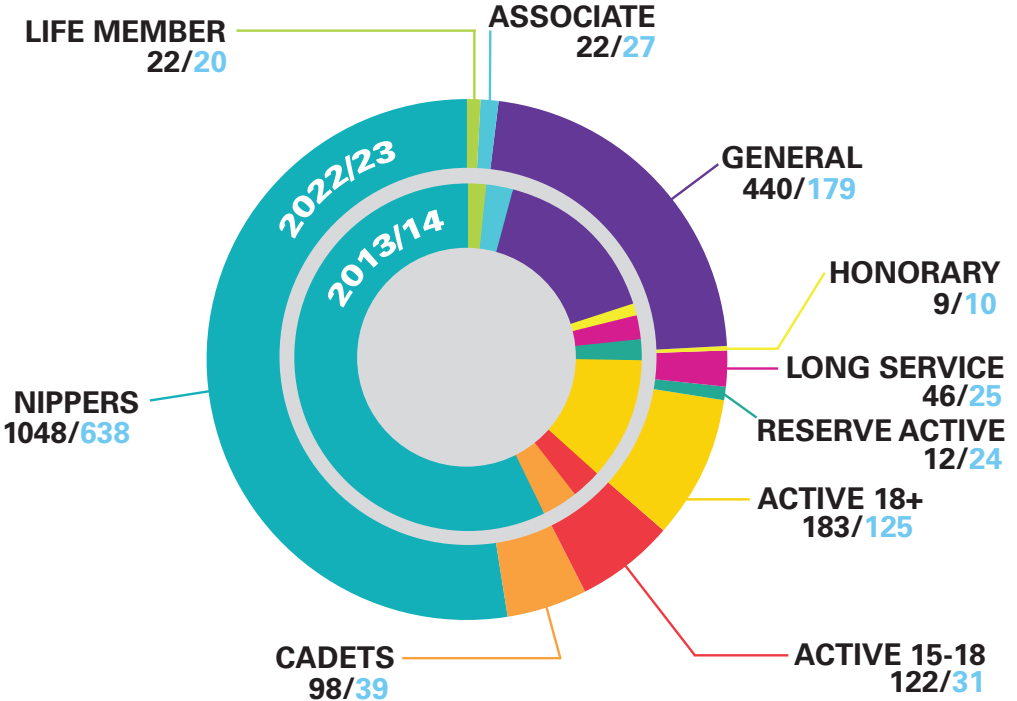

DIRECTOR OF FINANCE’S REPORT



It is with great pleasure to present you the annual financial report for the South Maroubra Surf Life Saving Club Inc. for the 2022/23 financial year.

The club reported a net profit of \$159,290 (compared to \$171,287 in FY21/22), representing a significant result considering the significant expenditure in renovations as outlined in the building report.

During the financial year ending 30th April 2023, the club recorded a **total revenue of \$1,121,722** which is up 58% from previous season (**\$708,942** FY21/22).

Donations, Grants & Sponsorship increased by 26% over the past 12 months.

The Juniors Group and Maroubra Seals Club provided a combined \$32,730 through the Club Grants Scheme with funds being expensed on Lifesaving Equipment.

This season, we welcomed three new partners to our Club, Hutch Legal, NixCo and Holfords Pool Services. We’re looking forward to a long and successful partnership. Your generous support is greatly appreciated.

Club’s In-Kind support to the community, as part of our support and give back to the community, this season we hosted a number of organisations for a variety of activities at our club house. To name a few, the Clontarf foundation sent several groups of young members that stayed at our club house for 2 to 3 nights. We hosted Randwick City Council, NSW Police, St Therese Mascot Primary School, Corpus Christi College – Maroubra, Lycee Condorcet – The International French School of Sydney, and a large number of community sporting organisations, such as The South Maroubra Dolphins Winter Swimming Club, The Coobras (Maroubra) Swimming Club, South Sydney Rabbitohs, Maroubra Lions FC, Sydney University Water polo Club and Moore Park FC.

Clubhouse Income is derived from Heritage Room hire, BK Bar sales, Club Kiosk and Horizons Lease contract. The Heritage room generated a total of \$181,191 (\$96,000 FY21/22) with a positive uplift from Sunday Socials and Room Hire.

Total Membership stands at 2,002
Our Nipper membership this season represented the largest group nationally with 1,048 members.

Events & Fundraising revenue doubled with strong and active fundraising across all divisions despite not conducting our annual Fun Run/Oktoberfest Community Event or Annual Golf Day. Fortunately, we were able to conduct successful Sportsman Lunch, Trivia Night, and re-introduced the IRB Comedy Night and had our second Ocean Swim activities. Thanks to all our competition sections for their yearly commitment to fundraising to assist the funding of our State and Aussie Touring Teams.

Merchandise Sales grew by 28% this year but these were offset by higher costs as the club switched to higher quality swimwear and design with a net loss this year of \$6,164 (\$15,951 profit FY21/22). We have increased our new design merchandise stock on hand to the value of \$30,247.81.

Sundry Income is made up from First Aid/BM/ SRC course fees, Touring Team contribution, sale of retired equipment and payments made by nippers for non-club endorsed carnival entry fees.

This form of income is up \$67,712 (\$43,644 FY21/22) due primarily from an insurance claim payout and the sale of retired equipment.

During the past financial period the club showed a 79% increase in expenditure. 22/23 reports **total Expenditure at \$962,432** compared to \$537,655 FY21/22.

Admin and General Operating expenses were slightly up at \$105,122 (\$97,295 FY21/22) driven primarily due to increase in Capitation fees and the new Accounting and POS systems.

Building & Property expenditure increased this financial year to \$240,373 due to the renovation of the bar and the painting of the exterior (\$91,262 FY21/22).

Competition expenditure of \$110,484 (\$89,670 FY21/22) saw an uplift as a direct result of more competitors in the cadet age group and the Aussies being located in Perth this year incurring additional costs. This increase was offset by the team contribution and fundraising activities as mentioned above.

Lifesaving expenditure
To support our Lifesaving commitment to ensure a safe aquatic environment at South Maroubra, investment was made in the purchase of new a new ATV \$24,750, Lifesaving equipment \$18,495 (\$16,020 FY21/22) and IRB Equipment \$27086 (\$10,100 FY21/22).

Expenses occurred via the maintenance of lifesaving equipment and provision of patrol lunches for our volunteer Lifesavers (\$23,931), Education/Lifesaving Awards and courses \$17,771, first aid supplies, lifesaving patrol apparel \$ 47,703 and IRB Service & Repairs \$ 9,278.

Nipper expenditure increased significantly to \$104,266 (\$58,412) with inclusion this year of Capitation fees \$24,067, new much needed equipment \$10,909 (\$1,444 FY21/22) and larger number of competitors incurring competition Fees \$22,391 (\$16,471 FY21/22). It should be noted as above, this was offset by the doubling of fundraising during the year.

Events & Fundraising figures are higher primarily due to the associate cost of Bar Stock \$55,277 (\$34,221 FY21/22) and the Gold Members Day function. The Board held a Sponsors Function.

Member Expenses decreased slightly this year to \$31,371 (\$33,462 FY 21/22).

This season we celebrated the re-open our club bar and provided a number of club functions (including Presentation night) and incentives for the over 18 years membership. We maintained the 40s+ Fitness program.

Depreciation – our financial statement stays on the path of our 13-year cycle of \$53,000 per annum deduction (Amortization) from our financial books to remove the listed clubhouse Land and Building value from \$700,000 to zero.

In Summary:
As the community saw the backend of COVID-19, our revenues saw a strong uptick via Clubhouse income with the return to normal lease arrangements with TopCat, the increasing popular Sunday Socials and increased room hire. This allowed us fund needed building maintenance with the overall financial position of the club remaining sound.

Thanks to our Club Licensee Gus Taylor and his right-hand man Tony Shaw and our bar staff for their efforts this year. Thanks to Uri for assisting me in getting the Epos and Accounting systems in place. A big thank you to our Caretakers Barry & Leslie and Michelle Lo in the office. Like in previous seasons, all the above members have worked extremely hard this past year, along with the Board of Management Committee, to ensure our members and supporters enjoyed their time spent at South Maroubra Surf Club.

Huge thanks to Tracey Teitler for assisting me once again this season in getting our financial reports ready for the Auditors.

In closing, I congratulate all our members for their efforts throughout the year.

I have done the best I could do, within my knowledge and capabilities to ensure our finances were managed appropriately and our club remains financially sound.

I would like to thank my fellow board members for your continuous support and guidance.

The financial statements cover the South Maroubra Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated as a not-for-profit individual entity domiciled in Australia.

NOTE 1. SUMMARY OF MATERIAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Act (NSW) 2009*, the *Incorporation Regulation (NSW) 2016*, the *Charitable Fundraising Act (NSW) 1991*, and the *Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012*. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity, as it is unlikely there to exist users who are unable to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specifically all of their information needs.

The basis for the decision to prepare a Special Purpose Report is the ACNC guidelines which state that charities with an annual revenue of more than \$250,000 but under \$1 million are classified as medium size and can submit a Special Purpose Report.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Act (NSW) 2009*, the NSW Charitable Fundraising Act and Regulations, the *Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012*, and the following Australian Accounting Standards:

Any material accounting estimates, judgments and errors would be fully disclosed if applicable; for this report there are none.

No other applicable Australian Accounting Standards, Urgent Issue Group Consensus Views or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Boards have been applied.

The financial report is also prepared on an accrual basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuation of non-current assets.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this report.

Income Tax

The Club is exempt from payment of income tax under the present provision of the Income Tax Act.

Building

The building in which the Club is situated is shown in the accounts as having a net value of \$491,658. In the event of a termination of the lease of the premises, it is anticipated that the building would not have a realisable value. The cost of the building will be depreciated over the remaining term of the lease with Randwick City Council due to expire 30th June 2031.

NOTE 1. SUMMARY OF MATERIAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

Events Subsequent to Balance Date

There were no significant events occurring after balance date.

Cash Flow Information

The Club has no credit stand-by or finance facilities in place.

Insurance

A Public Liability Insurance Policy is held by the Surf Life Saving Association of Australia Providing inter alia cover for the Club and members of the Club whilst engaged in lifesaving activities or properly authorised duties as approved by the Club.

Fundraising Activities

Net fundraising is applied to the operational expenses of the Club/Branch in its core lifesaving activities.

Charitable Fundraising Act 1991: this Act and supporting Charitable Fundraising Regulations prescribe the manner in which fundraising appeals are conducted, controlled and reported in NSW. The amounts shown at Note 9 are in accordance with the Authority Condition 7, which is issued to the Club under section 19 of the Act.

Donations and bequests: These are returned as income as and only when received at the Club's administration office or deposited into the Club's bank account. As specified in the Act, unsolicited donations, members' donations and bequests are not treated as fundraising income when determining information required under the Act.

Cost of fundraising: Cost use in Note 9 includes all direct fundraising costs in accordance with the Act. The inclusion of indirect costs is discretionary. Excluded indirect costs include overheads such as the time spent by accounting or office staff administering appeals, cost apportionment of rent, light and power, and insurance. Exclusion of the indirect costs decreases the cost of fundraising.



BUILDING COORDINATOR'S REPORT



Another big hello to Members, Supporters and Sponsors. I am very pleased to report that on the building front we continue work on providing a facility that accommodates our ever-increasing lifesaving and community needs, massively growing membership, and participation at all levels of operation which means we need to use what space we have wisely plus ensure the building is well maintained and everyone chips in to look after this proud old building of ours.

In last year's annual report, the following works were well underway and expected to be completed this season which I'm pleased to advise did occur and will be reported on below.

South Maroubra Board of Management appreciates the importance of constant maintenance and works hard on improving, protecting, and growing our facilities along with planning for the future which continues behind the scenes. It is hoped that in the next season or two, the Board of Management will be able to reveal the exciting future plans for our club.

This season and post Covid we experienced a massive following by the public and members who enjoyed our hospitality and our newly constructed BK bar which worked a treat catering for the massive interest.

This year we have:

- Completed the costly external rendering and full repaint of the club in consultation with our partner Top Cat Catering ensuring the colour scheme and works enhance their business and improves the aesthetics of our footprint.
- Our major renovation planning remains on track although we are putting a hold on further planning for a couple of months whilst in discussions with Randwick City Council.

- Upgraded the club entry with a new privacy screen and native plants which allows storage behind the screen creating for a more professional main entry point.

As you can see it has been another full-on season with club works most of which has been totally funded by the club through good financial management. That said, it would be remiss of me

not to acknowledge the major contributions of Randwick City Council and a very big thanks to Michael Daley MP and the NSW Governments Community Building Partnership.

DIRECTOR OF LIFESAVING SERVICES' REPORT



We really had a spectacular summer for the 2022/23 season! With some great weather and conditions, it means we were able to spend more time on the sand and in the water doing what we do best.

The season hasn't been without its challenges, but overall, we have had another successful season.

This season we saw Ashleigh Breaden come on as the new Lifesaving Registrar, as well as Codie as the new Education Coordinator, with the rest of the leadership team within the Lifesaving Portfolio remaining the same. However, we did see some changes in the team in the second half of the season with Laurie stepping down as IRB Coordinator, as well as Codie stepping down as Education Coordinator. Considering the time of the year I stood in these roles in an acting capacity.

As usual we kicked off the season with gear inspection, this year was a mix of the old and new form of gear inspection with us being able to tick off some items and having other items such as IRBs and motors checked by the team at Sydney Branch. A big thank you to everyone who helped get all the gear ready in the lead up and helped conduct the checks, but particularly to Ken, Darren, Laurie, William, Ashleigh, Codie, and Maria who put in a lot of work making sure we were ready.

Patrols this season have been great, and I was happy to be able to get down to visit all the teams this past season and talk with our Patrol Captains and team members. With the growth in our active patrolling members, we had 15 patrol teams supported by two active reserve

teams. Our member retention, particularly in youth membership (175% in cadets, 242% in Active 15- 18 since 2016/17), is the highest it has been for years. Overall, we have seen a 105% growth in our active patrolling members since 2016 (Active 18+, Active 15-18 and Cadets). We are putting through more awards now than we have for many years. This has been a lot of dedicated work by the lifesaving team over the 5 seasons and as a club are in a really healthy space for continued growth. With

stability in our member retention and a great influx of new lifesavers we will likely see our patrol team numbers grow, as well as many taking up new skills means we're able to ensure those visiting the beach remain safe. Our members logged 13253 hours this season.

"

With some great beach days, we certainly saw a healthy number of visitors (63539). Our rescues (70) were performed with a number of different equipment including the IRB (32), rescue board (22) and rescue tube (12), which demonstrates how important the equipment and skills of our lifesavers is. I was happy to see the number of preventative actions (2520), and to know that our members are

keeping a keen eye on swimmers from various vantage points on the beach and from an elevated position in our Patrol Tower and being proactive in swimmer interventions keeping them safe. After all, our purpose of existing as a club is to keep our beaches safe. I'm glad to report that again we had no lives lost between the flags.

DIRECTOR OF LIFESAVING SERVICES' REPORT

EDUCATION

Recruitment, training, and upskilling has been a big focus over the last few seasons, and this season was no different. Continuing with the inclusion of the Bronze Transition and SRC intensive courses, we ran two Transition Intensives and one SRC intensive this season. This has been a great addition to our offerings, giving our experienced kids an opportunity to get through their courses more quickly. In addition to this we added in the first aid course to all bronze medallion courses and in our last bronze course of the season we added in the Advanced Resuscitation course which meant those who completed the course finished with their Bronze Medallion, First Aid Certificate and the Advanced Resuscitation Certificate, and ultimately knowledgeable lifesavers.

We are a small education team but we put through a great number of awards this season with a total of 343 awards this season, the third highest amount for Sydney Branch after Coogee (471) and Bondi (415). When you consider the membership base and the number of trainers they have, we as a Club should be extremely proud of the results delivered.

We have an impressive 136 new lifesavers this season, including 79 new Bronze Medallion holders, as well as 57 new Surf Rescue Certificate holders. With oxygen administration no longer a part of the BM course it was important we had more members' upskill in the Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate (ARTC), this season we trained 47 more on this vital skill. The one-day intensive ARTC course continues to be well received by our members.

Additionally, we trained 22 of our nipper kids in the Resuscitation awards and these kids are well on their way to becoming SRCs in future years. In our IRB space we put through 24 new IRB Crew, as well as 11 new IRB Drivers. We've also

had members take up higher awards such as the Silver Medallion Aquatic Rescue (4), senior First Aid Certificate (86), as well as a few through the new Silver Medallion Patrol Captain (3) course which kicked off late in the season. These higher awards provide us with members who will have a greater awareness and capability while on patrol. Finally, but by no means the least, it's also been great to see new trainers join our training team. We can never have enough trainers and I hope we can see even more join us in the new season. If this interests you, come and have a chat with me or one of our trainers to learn what it's all about.

I have to thank Codie Wem who put her hand up to be the Education Coordinator this season, while personal and work commitments meant she was not able to see out the season she was a great help while she was able to assist. It did mean I needed to pick up the reins again as the Education coordinator, which was again a massive task, but I do truly love training and in the least enjoyable. Particularly seeing candidates come out the end with big smiles in their face and proud of their great achievement. Thankfully I had the help of Maria Garay who is in her second year as a trainer and was always willing to help wherever I needed her, which very rightfully saw her win Rookie Trainer of the Year. A shout out also needs to go to Isabella Garay who took on more leadership in the Bronze training space and saw her awarded Trainer of the Year.

A big thank you to all our Trainers and Assessors. Without your continued effort each and every season, giving up your personal time on top of your regular patrols, we would not be in the position we are today. I genuinely appreciate all you give to education at the club and look forward to working with you all again next season.

We saw a successful but also challenging season in the lifesaving IRB space, with many lessons learnt. After close to 5 years in the role we saw Laurie Golsby step down midseason. Laurie has been a great leader in the IRB space and in many aspects, we would not be in such a healthy space if it weren't for him. As he would say - Boats are floating and motors are running.

The section hasn't skipped a beat with the same dedicated lifesaving members showing up time and time again. Particularly I'd like to thank Rene Prochnow, who once again has always been there to support in patrol and training. A big thank you also goes to Ben Keenan-Smith who was a great help and ear when I needed it, especially in taking over the IRB Coordinator role midseason. His support of me and the section saw him award Lifesaving IRB Person of the Year. Both Rene and Ben have by far the most dedicated in this section this year.

This season the section continued to grow with new recruits and we were able to get our usual number of courses running again with 24 new IRB Crew and 11 new Drivers. Running IRB training is always challenging, considering the number of surfers, swimmers, and conditions, we see our candidates having to be on the beach ready to go at first light. With challenging conditions and new operators, we saw a few thrills and spills, but with new improved procedures have seen our course run more smoothly still with the thrills but certainly with less spills.

Our growing IRB operator numbers have not dipped in quality and ensure safe operation of our IRB fleet moving into our 2023/24 season. The training team this year consisted of Laurie Golsby, Andrew Wem, Ben Keenan-Smith, Scott Hobday, Coco McCarthy, and Damien Woods. The level of training and depth of knowledge and initiative from this training team continue to impress me and deliver quality recruits.

Our resources are not only used to keep our beach safe but to provide water safety to a number of lifesaving events and community events. I would like to express my gratitude to those who have assisted in all water safety events at the various carnivals throughout the season. Thank you to all those who put up their hand to support our club in addition to everything you already do.

A special thank you to our IRB competition team that helped out with our club's Ocean Swim. This saw 5 boats on the water for the entirety of the event to assist on the day. Maintenance and replenishing gear in our section is of high priority in this section. With assistance from Ken Hudson, Greg Morris, and other members our gear has been taken great care of.

I would like to send my thanks to those who have helped me through this season, particularly as I took over the section midseason with a lot of other commitments on my plate. Whether it was to give advice, help pick up training sessions or a call out for water safety you were all there to help. The section is well supported and ready for season 2023/24.

I look forward to the 2023/24 season and seeing you all on the beach.

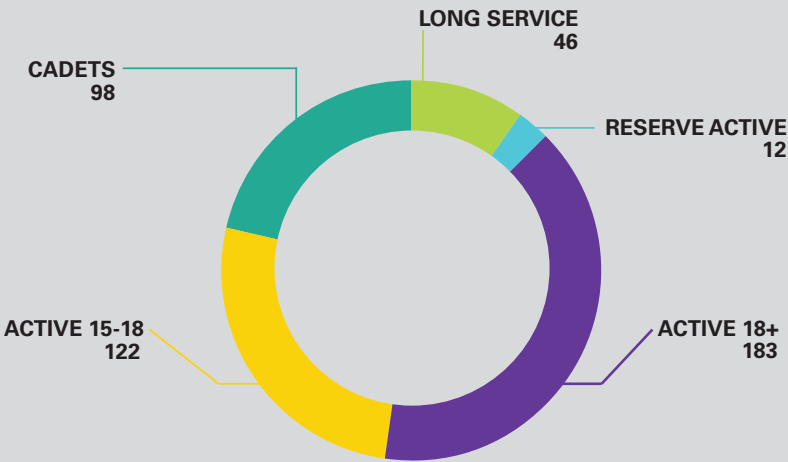

It is rewarding to see how these young athletes develop to become great lifesavers.

This season the Touring Team Manager position was meticulously led by Renae McNamara. Renae's work ethic and organisational skills are second to none. The detailed communication which we were always provided with meant that we all knew where we supposed and when, which is no mean feat. Renae, thank you for keeping us so well organised. We are forever grateful and we would not have had such a successful season without you. Congratulations to Ryan MacNamara, Rory Muldowney, Krishna Inder & Christopher Kondilios for being selected to be a part of the Sydney Interbranch Team. Christopher also went on to represent NSW at the Interstate Championships.

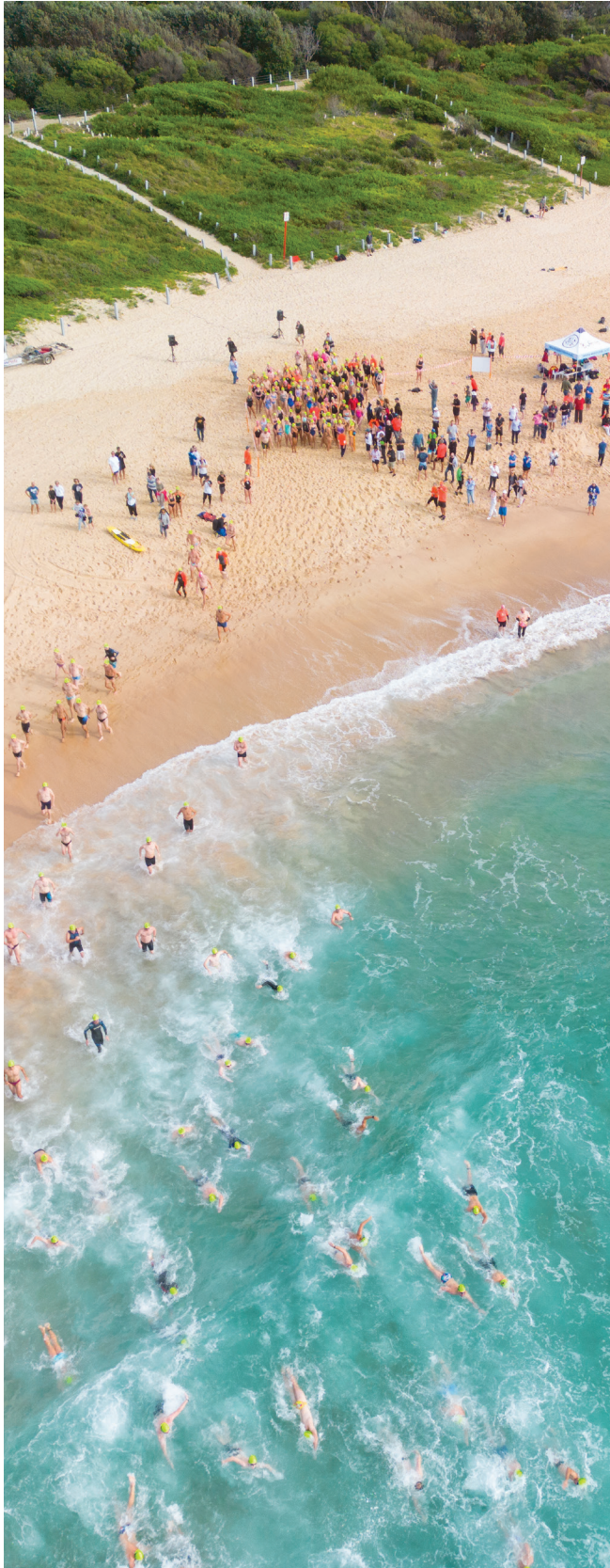

Cathie has trained (is still training) our lifesavers for over 20 years. Cathie has won all the club's prestigious awards being:

- Club Person of the Year (2005/6)
- Most Outstanding Senior of the Year (twice)
- Senior Lifesaver of the Year
- Training Officer of the Year (2003/4, 2009/10)
- Patrol Captain of the year
- South Maroubra Surf Lifesaving Club Honour Blazer

Cathie also won the Surf lifesaving Sydney Branch award for the Branch Assessor of the year.

Cathie has achieved 100% patrol efficiency every year since joining the Club and has completed more than 450 hours on the beach.

Cathie is a great mentor for many female lifesavers at South Maroubra. In March 2008, Cathie was selected from almost 100 nominees as one of the 12 finalists in the 2008 NSW Woman of the year awards for her outstanding contribution to the community and lifesaving.



Cathie is not only an educator and lifesaver, but she is also a successful competitor. In 2006 Cathie competed in her first IRB carnival at the world titles in Lorne with her daughter Emma. Cathie really enjoyed IRB competition and competed up until 2018 and was part of the South Maroubra team that won its first IRB State Titles points score.

Cathie is South Maroubra's most successful female IRB competitor with:

- 12 State Gold medals,
- 12 State Silver medals,
- 19 State Bronze, and
- 3 Australian Bronze Medals
- 2 Australian Silver Medals

Cathie has also competed in the Masters at State and in the First Aid.
