SOUTH MAROUBRA COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN MEMBER CLUB USE INDUCTION

Overview

The purpose of this COVID-19 Safety Plan Member Induction is to provide a guide for the use of all Club facilities. The rules set out in this document are intended to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 among members, participants, coaches, officials, administrators/volunteers, visitors, families and the broader community. The induction provides the framework to govern the general operation of the Club and the facilities it controls.

At all times this document is subject to all regulations, guidelines and directions of government and public health authorities.

Member Safety

South Maroubra Surf Life Saving Club expects all members, participants, coaches, officials, administrative staff and volunteers to:

- Comply with the health directions of government and public health authorities as issued from time to time;
- Understand and act in accordance with this Induction as amended from time to time;
- Comply with any testing and precautionary measures implemented by South Maroubra Surf Life Saving Club;
- Act with honesty and integrity in regard to the state of their personal health and any potential symptoms; and
- Monitor their health and take a cautious approach to self-isolation and reporting of potential symptoms.

Club use guidelines

All facilities have been assessed and appropriate upgraded hygiene protocols, physical distancing and other measures have been put in place to mitigate the risk of transmission of COVID-19.

You must adhere to room number limits; signs are posted at each room entry. If you arrive at a room do a count before entering. Do not enter if the room the room is a capacity, arrange another time to come back.

The following are available in all rooms:

- Sign-in sheet
- Hand sanitiser
- Surface spray + wipes
- Bin for disposal of wipes

Members **MUST** ensure they do the following when attending the club and using any facilities:

Number, distancing and registration

- Swipe into the club. All doors must be closed after entry (not chocked open)
- Sign in on the available sign in sheet for the room/facility being used
- Adhere to 1.5m distancing
- The use of greetings such as handshakes, hugs, kisses are discouraged
- Don't loiter

Cleaning and hygiene

- Use hand sanitiser upon entry
- Wipe all surfaces used before exiting the room/facility
- Members are encouraged to not share equipment and to be sure to wipe all equipment between use
- No personal items are to be left at the club

Gym Members

- Book using online booking system supplied to all gym members
- Follow all the gym use guidelines supplied

We encourage all members to download the Governments COVIDSafe app and to have it on when attending the Club.

MOST IMPORTANTLY IF YOU ARE NOT FEELING WELL DO NOT ATTEND THE CLUB. STAY HOME AND GET TESTED IF NEEDED. IF YOU TEST POSITIVE CONTACT THE CLUB PRESIDENT TO CONFIDENTIALLY REPORT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTACT TRACING.

Responsibility of Board of Management & Members

Section Directors will initially be responsible for induction/training their committee members, following on from those it's important that committee members then induct and train any members they're responsible for.

Ultimately it is important that **ALL** members are compliant with this Induction and the Covid-19 Safety Plan. A certain amount of self-regulation is required. Members will be monitored by the BOM, Club Caretaker and Club Office via the installed CCTV. If you would like to view the Club CCTV policy, please refer to the Club website.

Noncompliance with these guidelines will result in removal of access to that room for member in breach, or complete closure of that room/facility. Once again, it's important that we are all mindful of our fellow members, that we self-regulate and communicate with each other.
